In accordance with the Chief Justice's directive to limit court over the next 30 days, Superior Court in Greene and Lenoir County will be handled as follows:

March 16 – Lenoir County Criminal Superior – All cases are to be continued EXCEPT bond motions, first appearances and cases involving the initial appointment of counsel.

March 23 – Lenoir County Civil Superior – Session cancelled.

March 30 - Lenoir County Criminal Superior – All cases are to be continued EXCEPT bond motions, first appearances and cases involving the initial appointment of counsel.

April 6 – Lenoir County Criminal Superior Administrative – Grand Jury does NOT need to report; all cases are to be continued EXCEPT bond motions, first appearances and cases involving the appointment of counsel; on Thursday, April 9, all probation violation hearings to be continued EXCEPT those regarding the initial appointment of counsel, first appearances and bond matters. The Court will entertain, with due consideration given to the health and safety of all involved parties and court personnel, providing proper safety precautions can be undertaken, probation violation hearings for in-custody defendants ONLY.

April 13 – Greene County Criminal Superior - All cases are to be continued EXCEPT bond motions, first appearances and cases involving the initial appointment of counsel.
