

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING**  
**THE LENOIR COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**  
**“ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NOISE CONTROL**  
**IN LENOIR COUNTY”**

Be it and it is hereby ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Lenoir County, North Carolina as follows

Section 1: The Lenoir County “ Ordinance Providing for Noise Control in Lenoir County” adopted June 2, 1981 and as amended may 3, 1982 is hereby amended as follows:

“Section 4(a). Maximum permissible sound levels by use occupancy is amended by rewriting Table I, Sound Levels By Use Occupancy Category to read as follow:

Table I

SOUND LEVELS BY USE OCCUPANCY CATEGORY

<u>USE OCCUPANCY CATEGORY</u>	<u>TIME</u>	<u>SOUND LEVEL LIMIT dB(A)</u>
Commercial or Business	6 a.m. – 11 p.m. 11 a.m. – 6 a.m.	75 dB(A) 60 dB(A)
Manufacturing, Industrial, or Agricultural	AT ALL TIMES	75 dB(A)

For any source of sound, the maximum sound level shall not exceed the osund level on Table 1 above by 15 dB(A) for all categories.

Section 2: This ordinance amendment shall be effective from adoption.
